TIPS OF THE TRADE

- Always mount your curtains all the way up to the crown molding or the ceiling. This will make your ceilings look higher.
- · Don't forget the fifth wall. Use your ceiling as a way to add more color or pattern with wallpaper or a colorful paint.
- An area rug that is too small can ruin a room. Twelve inches is the optimal distance for an edge border in most spaces.
- · When hanging a light fixture or chandelier over a dining table, place it thirty inches to thirty-six inches above the table to allow for a centerpiece.
